Therapy required:

Physical and Occupational

Timeline:

Therapy 6 days per week. Start of care—July 4, 2021 End of care—July 16, 2021 After falling down at home, Delores Hodge soon learned that she had fractured her femur, requiring surgical repair followed by in-patient rehabilitation.

Her husband, Forrest, was already very familiar with the compassionate care available at Our Lady of the Valley, so it was his first call. The admissions team worked quickly over the Fourth of July weekend to ensure that Delores' therapy started immediately.
