# Be My Valentine

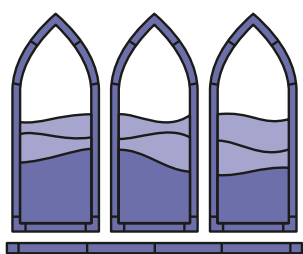
