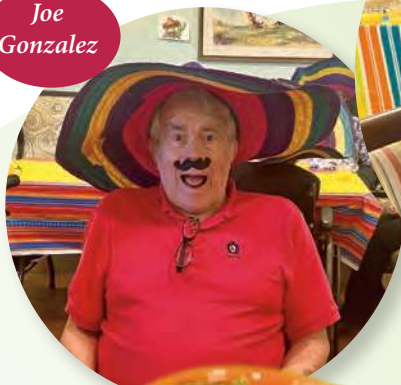

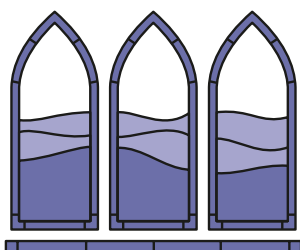


Have You Heard?
